

WORKSHOP MEETING

Town of Berlin

Meeting Date: August 28, 2025,
Call to Order: 7:04 p.m.

Held at: 17563 State Rte. 22

Town board members present:

Councilman Maxon, Councilman Doug Feathers, and Supervisor Jaeger.
Councilman Riccardi and Councilman Winn were absent.

Supervisor Jaeger opened the meeting with the signing of the bills. Supervisor Jaeger made a motion to accept the bills as read. Councilman Doug Feathers seconded the motion.

Supervisor Jaeger reported that the board has received a letter from the engineer stating that the property at 111 Green Hollow Rd. has been deemed inhabitable and needs to be demolished. The owner was notified of this status and will need to obtain a building permit for demolition.

Taconic Valley Rescue Squad has been collecting fees for service through Medicaid. They have been notified that the Town of Berlin is only one that can collect the fees, since the town holds the certificate of operation. The board has agreed to create a new account through Pioneer to collect these fees on behalf of TVA.

Supervisor Jaeger approached the board regarding a resolution to Authorize Taconic Valley Ambulance to Erect and Maintain a Station in the Town Complex at 17563 NY 22. The resolution was passed.

The board discussed the new water rate increase. There will be a 50% increase for October 1, 2025. The notice will be posted on the website, and a call will be placed to residents within the water district notifying them of the increase.

Councilman Riccardi entered the meeting room at 7:28PM

The board has approved a rabies clinic for October 2025.

Having no further business to conduct Councilman Maxon made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Supervisor Jaeger seconded the motion.
